

# ESCA History: Past, Present, Future

## The ESCA provides the following:

Army funding for dedicated munitions remediation

Funds for U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and CA Department of Toxic and Substances Control (DTSC) oversight

FORA reuse and remedial work coordination

Transfer of approximately 3,340 acres to FORA

Safe and effective munitions remediation

## Early transfer process

Legislation created to allow for early transfer of BRAC properties

Army must agree to the transfer

Receiving entity (FORA) required to comply with all environmental requirements

EPA must concur with the transfer

Final approval rests with state governor

Transfer becomes final
